Attraction Attendant*

Responsibilities Include:

- Overseeing various attractions including large interactive inflatables, specialty equipment, carnival games, our water slide, and more!
- Ensuring proper equipment operation and completing pre-event safety inspection and checklist
- Providing information to, guaranteeing safety of, and ensuring enjoyment for all event attendees

Buffet/Cart/Food Attendant*

Responsibilities Include:

- Managing buffet and concession stations
- Maintaining, preparing, and refreshing food items and condiments
- Set up and break down of food service station(s)
- Food service (food handler's license not required)

Hostess*

Responsibilities Include:

- Preparation of welcome booth
- Greeting and welcoming guests and providing them with general event information
- Assisting Event Manager as necessary

Event Manager

Responsibilities Include:

- Being the primary point of contact for the client contact as well as overseeing/ facilitating management of all on-call event staff
- Must have excellent communication skills and the ability to think on your feet
- Overseeing general event timeline and details in order to ensure the best possible experience for all guests

MC/Games Coordinator

Responsibilities Include:

- Leading coordinated picnic races and group games (all required materials and list of games provided - or bring your own!)
- Making announcements and assisting clients with raffles, etc (as necessary)
- The ideal candidate for this position is well-spoken, can go with the flow, has a flair for the dramatic, and prides themselves on having personality galore!

Lifeguard

Responsibilities Include:

- Overseeing safety of patrons at pool
- Must provide proof of current lifeguard and CPR certificates

Driver

Responsibilities and Requirements Include:

- Valid Driver's License (Class C License Accepted) with clean DMV record
- Driving of small box trucks and vans to and from various off-site events
- Ability to load and unload event equipment

Chef

Responsibilities and Requirements Include:

- On-site food preparation
- Food service (as necessary)
- Ability to effectively communicate with on-call food service staff and Event Manager

Because of the varying nature of our events, we are always in need of friendly, people-oriented staff to work a wide variety of positions. The above are some of our standard positions, but each event is unique and requires a unique combination positions.
